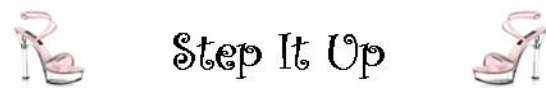
Food items needed, include:

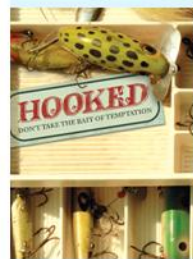
